

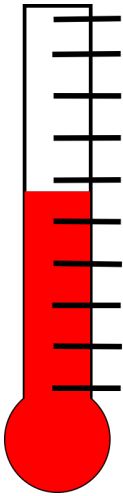


Marie LEAD DEAF Hondurans

January was a full month, as I traveled to Honduras and back, as well as to 6 different states to share my ministry in multiple churches. I met many new friends, gained new partners in ministry, and added 3000 miles to my car! February was **full of travel** as well, but almost all within MD, and included a visit to the church where I got saved, 22

years ago. My parents came to see me present my work! Continue to pray for me as I plan to travel through GA, OH, and VA in upcoming weeks.

The 10-day **medical missions trip to Honduras** in the beginning of January went very, very well. It was a blessing and encouragement to work with my future teammates (Team Honduras missionaries and Honduran church members). My responsibility as a nurse was overseeing the triage section of the clinic. My Spanish got a work-out with several thousand patients coming through, as did my small LESHO
