



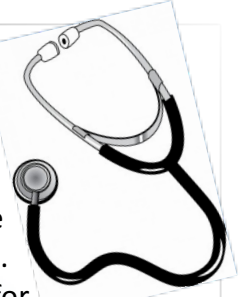

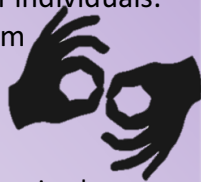
I am receiving almost **90% monthly support** since beginning deputation in August, 2015. Thank you for your generosity! Also, thank you to the many individuals and churches who have recently contributed to my **"Start-up Fund"** via my website donate button or check. God has blessed through your generosity, and all of the funds (\$30k) needed to move to Honduras have come in! I plan to move to Honduras this January. Please pray for wisdom with moving details.

This month I will be taking a 2 week **Missionary Medicine Intensive** course in Marion, NC. Though my concentration in Honduras will be working with Deaf, there will be multiple opportunities where I will be in contact with nationals needing healthcare. I want to be prepared for anything God has for me. Please pray I learn and retain the information given, that I may use this avenue to touch those who are hurting.



This October I will be taking a 4-week, online course through Gallaudet University in preparation to take the second half of the **National Interpreter Certification** test (for sign language). Honduran sign language is about 60% different from American Sign Language (ASL); however, being certified in ASL will help me develop interpreting and signing *techniques*, as well as earn respect from international interpreters, Deaf educators, and families of Deaf individuals. Please pray that I pass this exam and thus become better equipped to reach the Deaf for Christ.

Over 13,000 Deaf people from around the world attended this secular, four-day, Deaf convention. Among the many vendors and entertainers, our team of 39 soul-winners manned two tables and witnessed to hundreds of Deaf people, using gestures, American Sign Language (ASL), pictures, or whatever method we needed to, to communicate! Almost 100 precious people (mostly Deaf) trusted Christ as their Savior. Personally, I led 1 hearing person and 4 Deaf people to Christ, as well as witnessed to many other Deaf people from multiple countries, representing several religions. Thank you for praying for us!

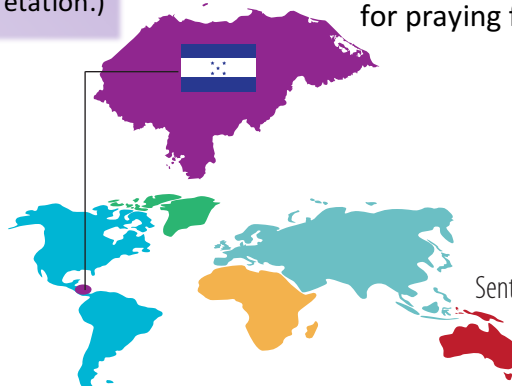
