

Medical Missions Outreach (medical-outreach.com) arrived August 17 to conduct an annual, 4½ day, clinic, in cooperation with our church. About 100 volunteers from our church joined the 76 volunteers and medical professionals that came. We were able to offer dental, vision, physical therapy, surgical, and general medical services to over 3,500 patients! Best of all, every patient is given a 1:1 presentation of the Gospel before they leave the clinic.

This was the first year we were able to provide a sign language interpreter (me) for Deaf patients. Eight Deaf people came for dental, vision, and general medical services, and were given a DVD of the Gospel in sign language so they could watch it as many times as they'd like!
